

LIFE RIGHT NOW Nehemiah 6:1-14 March 1st, 2020 Pastor Adam Fix

Read Nehemiah 6:1-14

What is the condition of the wall around Jerusalem? How does having much of the work finished, but not yet having doors affect the lives of the people?

How does the plot against Nehemiah unfold? What are the accusations? What other means of deception are part of this plot?

What should we learn from Nehemiah's response? How does he know it is a trap? Has your faith been tested by those around you? How do we persevere in faith when we are slandered, betrayed, or taken advantage of?

What will be a part of the lives of Christians now that Jesus has died on the cross and risen again, but we still await his second coming? What happened at his first coming and what will happen when he comes again?

Read Hebrews 9:1-14. Put the theological truth this is describing in your own words. What long awaited promises have now become reality? Read Hebrews 9:15. How has Christ become the mediator of a new covenant?

Read Isaiah 41:10. These words are part of the hymn "How Firm a Foundation." Why is the church able to take up assurances originally given to the Messiah? What should we do when we are afraid?
