Read Ecclesiastes 6:1-12 (Groups: read it twice with different readers)

Who comes to mind when you think of someone wise? What is your relationship with this person like? Why do you think of them as wise?

What is the point of life? The preacher says it's possible to be wealthy and popular, but miss the point entirely (v. 1-6). Would you agree or disagree?

Read 1 Timothy 6:10. Where can the pursuit of money lead a person? How might someone be walking in that direction without even knowing it? What should be our goal instead (read 1 Timothy 6:11-12)?

Read John 6:27. How can we balance the necessities of our present life and the value of hard work with the right perspective in prioritizing things of eternal importance?

If you were to look back on this time in your life 20-30 years from now, what do you think you would remember most and be most proud of? What about this year will matter most in 20-30 years?

In verse 9, the Preacher says it's better to enjoy what is right in front of you than wishing for something else. Have you found this to be true? What have you lost by not appreciating what God has given you?
