When you consider your economic situation, do you most often compare yourself to those who are seemingly more wealthy or less wealthy than you? How does the time you live in and the place you live affect your understanding of wealth and prosperity?

Read John 6:35. Jesus fulfills our every longing and need. How can we remember and trust in this when we feel pulled by the riches of this world?
