Read Hebrews 10:19–25 (Groups: read it twice with different readers)

What does it mean to “go to church”? Where do you go? With whom are you there? Why do you go?

Why is each person’s presence in the local church important? Read 1 Corinthians 12:21–26.

What does it mean to “neglect to meet together”? Why would the writer of Hebrews warn and command against neglecting the gathering of God’s people?

Read Matthew 18:20. The context here is division within the church. Why is gathering together essential to unity in the body of Christ? Can a family well act like a family without joining together? Why or why not?

What type of encouragement are we to give one another? Read Hebrews 3:12–13. Are there differences between compliments and biblical encouragement? What are they? When might biblical encouragement be difficult to give?

How do we stir one another up to love? What is your part in our church doing this with one another? Encouraging others is the job of every church member; who can you encourage today?
