SERMON NOTES

STUDY QUESTIONS

Read Romans 12:9-11 (Groups: read it twice with different readers)

Who or what do you honor? Is honor earned, gifted, or both? How do you show honor when it is not easy for you to do so?

What is the difference between genuine and insincere love? If love is genuine, what will characterize it? Who does genuine love look to serve first? What about insincere love?

Read 1 Peter 4:8. In what way does love cover many sins? Why is it often beneficial to overlook offenses, especially those that are relatively minor? How does the Spirit work to promote lasting forgiveness between people?

What is spiritual laziness? What differentiates a spiritually lazy Christian from one who is energetically loving and serving others? Do you agree that God often supplies strength and energy when we are serving him and showing love to others?

Disagreement is a part of most relationships (family, friends, co-workers, church, etc.), how can you show honor to those you disagree with? Read Philippians 2:1-7.

What kind of work might you need to do to show honor to another person? What assumptions do you have that may need to be challenged? Read Romans 12:15 and Galatians 6:2. How will it help you to honor others if you understand what their burdens are and what they rejoice in?
