## STUDY QUESTIONS

Read Romans 15: 1–7 (Groups read it twice with different readers)

What does it mean to welcome someone? Think about what you would do to welcome a friend to your home, welcome a new neighbor to the neighborhood, or welcome a new member into your family?

Why, in the church, are the strong called to pay attention to and be patient with the weak? Can you think of other areas of life or society where this is done?

Who does Jesus welcome? Read Mark 2:13–17 and Luke 19:1–10. What pattern is present? Read Matthew 11:19.

Paul quotes Psalm 69:9 applying its words to Jesus, the Messiah. How have "the reproaches of those who reproach you" falling on Jesus made a way for us to be rescued and redeemed?

How is the nature of our relationships with one another in the church set in motion by first considering that, "Christ did not please himself"? How are you challenged and where do you fall short of joyfully seeking to obey verse 2?

What glorifies God in the church? Read again verses 5-7. How can we accomplish this when we disagree on certain points of doctrine, aspects of family life, present day political issues, and are different in real, meaningful ways? What should our hope be? How should we ask God to change our hearts?
