STUDY QUESTIONS

Read John 13: 34–35 (Groups: read it twice with different readers)

What does "God loves you" mean? How would you describe the love of God based on his Word, his character, and his actions?

If our love for one another is a reflection of God's love for us, how should we love each other?

What characteristics, attitudes, and actions should we be known for?

What are your strengths in showing love? What are your weaknesses in the same?

Read John 13:3-17. Why does Jesus choose to wash his disciples' feet as a symbol of his love for them?

How does a community where people regard one another as equals (not a higher master and a lower servant) cultivate a loving culture?

Read 1 Corinthians 13:1-7. Have you seen love break down barriers and a lack of love put them up? Why is it important for us to see this not as "advanced" love, but as the kind of love we expect to witness? Why should we be most eager to initiate this kind of love?

Do you need to repent of being unloving? Who do you need to pursue with love? Who do you need to humble yourself before and sacrifice to love more?
