## SERMON NOTES

### KNIT TOGETHER IN LOVE

Read Colossians 2:1-5 (Groups: read it twice with different readers)

What do you love about our church? What is God doing among this body that you rejoice in?

Based on verse 4, what would you assume is at the heart of Paul's concern for the Colossians? Have you ever known a person who has been deceived by eloquently presented, yet false beliefs? Why is it especially difficult to help someone when that is taking place?

Why are truth and love both essential to church unity? It can be difficult to know how to tenderly love someone in error or stay committed to truth where there are differing beliefs among people who love one another. What are some relational principles and heart postures that will help when you are not sure what to do?

Read Ephesians 4:1-3. Why should we be more eager to fight for unity than to separate? Why is it sad when Christians are divided? How should our desire for unity lead us to bear with one another in love? See also Colossians 3:13 and Romans 15:1.

Is understanding "God's mystery, which is Christ," open and a gift given to all believers? What divisions would ensue if only some Christians could understand Christ? How can any Christian grow deep in Christ?

How do we, as brothers and sisters in Christ, keep Christ preeminent among us? What must we refuse to divide over, to let sidetrack us, or to get in our way?
