SERMON QUESTIONS

Read Acts 2:37-42 (Groups: read it twice with different readers)

How would you describe your family culture? What milestones or events are particularly meaningful among those you are close with? What regular rhythms or habits reinforce these priorities?

What has Peter just said that gripped the hearts and minds of many among this large crowd? Why is the readiness of their response important?

Read Romans 6:1-4. What does baptism illustrate? Should we then conclude that baptism is necessary for salvation? Read Romans 3:21-26. How is a person saved?

Who should be baptized? Read Matthew 28:18-20. What common objections are given for refusing believers baptism? How are these objections answered?

Read 1 Corinthians 11:23-26. How does the Lord's Supper remind Christians of the sacrificial death of Jesus? Why is it important for us to routinely return to the source of our forgiveness?

Read 1 Corinthians 11:27-29. What does it mean to take communion in an unworthy manner? How do we examine our lives and hearts in preparation for this meal?
