SERMON QUESTIONS

Read John 19:28-42 (Groups: read it twice with different readers) Have you ever participated in a seder meal? If so, what were your impressions of that experience? How did Jesus teach his followers that he was giving new meaning to that ancient tradition?

What did Jesus mean when he said, "It is finished" (v. 30)? Be as specific as you can about the work Jesus accomplished.

Read Psalm 22:1, 15–18, 27–31. Why is it important for John (and other Gospel writers) to present Jesus as the fulfillment of Old Testament Scriptures?

Why did a soldier pierce Jesus' side? What does the discharge of blood and water indicate about the condition of his body? What does that discharge indicate about his divine and human nature?

How is the sovereignty of God seen in the death of Jesus? What comfort is this to you as you grieve the death of others and contemplate your own death? How does knowing Jesus preceded you in death give you hope that he will precede you in resurrection to new life if you are united to him?

Does the death of Jesus embolden you to preach the Gospel and testify to his victory over the grave? Especially given the beginning of Holy Week, who can you seize this opportunity to share the Gospel with?
