SERMON QUESTIONS

Read Proverbs 3:1-12 slowly and deliberately (Groups: read it twice with different readers) What does it mean to "keep" the commandments of God? If instead we were told to "guard" (another acceptable translation) God's commandments, how would that enhance your understanding of this instruction?

How will honoring God bring peace to your life (v. 2)? How can the writer of Proverbs suggest this when following the commandments of God often puts us at odds with the world? How do worldly peace and the peace of Christ differ?

What prevents you from completely trusting in God? In what areas of your life are you pulled to trust in something else? What else might you trust in?

Read Proverbs 26:12. Why is pride such an insidious temptation? How does it draw us away from God? What are the different ways sinful self-reliance hurts us?

Why is honoring God with first fruits the only way to truly magnify God's glory with your money? If you make giving a second, third, or lower priority, what are you actually saying is most important to you?

Read Hebrews 12:5–11. What does God's attention to discipline us say about his care for us? If you feel like you are currently in the throes of God's discipline, what is he trying to teach you?
