SERMON QUESTIONS

Read Proverbs 8 slowly and deliberately (Groups: read it twice with different readers)

When you need information, news, or perspective what sources do you go to? Who do you trust to tell you the truth?

Read verse 6. What's the difference between being told hard things and harsh things? Have you ever been corrected by someone who loves you and desires to help you? How did you respond differently than you likely would have if someone merely intended to criticize you?

How does the way God speaks wisdom to us model how we should speak with others? Read 2 Timothy 2:24-26.

Keeping your heart open to God can be a challenge. How do we stay open to receiving his love, discipline, and guidance? What are signals we are closing ourselves off to God?

Why should we keep God as Creator at the forefront of our thoughts as an act of devotion to him? In what ways will worshiping him this way help us to trust and obey him?

What hope does it give you that God can redeem anything and one day will redeem everything? Why is hope fundamental to the Christian life? How can you grow in the joy of the Lord today?
