SERMON QUESTIONS

Read Proverbs 13:22–24, 22:6 slowly and deliberately (Groups: read it twice with different readers) How does a loving parent serve and bless a son or daughter most? Why is diligent discipline a gift to a child?

Read Hebrews 12:7-11. Can you a recall a time where you endured hardship, but through it you were taught valuable lessons and came out wiser in the end? What were those circumstances and how have they shaped you?

How are children taught to know, love, and follow the Lord? What are the roles of instruction, discipline, and grace in parenting?

Injustice is present throughout our world. How does God's promise to act justly and one-day right wrongs comfort you? When you are tempted toward anger, bitterness, or retribution, how can you actively trust the plan and promises of God?

Read 1 Peter 3:18. If you are in Christ, how has God dealt with your unrighteousness? Does this change your perspective on justice and equity? Where do you hope to see more justice prevail as a gift of God's grace?

Who can you instruct, coach, and encourage to walk more closely with Christ? If you are a parent, part of your answer should be your child(ren), but you do not need to have children to coach people in the discipleship of Jesus.
