SERMON QUESTIONS

Read Jude 8-10 (Groups: read it twice with different readers)

How does a Christian trust in the promises of God during regular days? What is challenging about growing in Jesus day in and day out?

What does it mean to rely on dreams, defile the flesh, reject authority, and blaspheme the glorious ones (v. 8)?

Jude 8 marks a shift into the present tense. What do the four accusations tell us about the kinds of ungodliness we must be vigilant for?

Why does Jude choose Michael to illustrate his point? What about Michael's posture does Jude want his readers to emulate?

What should we denounce in the name of the Lord? There is a tendency when calling out sin to become arrogant, cynical, and unkind. How can we name and decry sin and that which opposes our Lord, all the while remaining gracious and hopeful?

Read 1 Corinthians 1:27-29. How is the wisdom of God heard by those of the world? What happens to people who trust in the world's wisdom? How can we entreat people to follow a better wisdom? (Hint: keep reading in 1 Corinthians)
