SERMON QUESTIONS

Read Jude 11–16 (Groups: read it twice with different readers)

What is your reaction to hearing about the judgment of God? Do you find it uncomfortable to talk about judgment? Why or why not?

Why is Jude referencing Cain, Balaam, and the people of Korah? What is he warning about from these three specific examples?

What do shepherds feeding themselves, waterless clouds, fruitless trees, waves casting up foam, etc. have to do with the condemnation Jude warns about?

What should we do when confronted with our sin, either by another person or by the Holy Spirit? Why is willful, ongoing sin so dangerous?

The antidote to grumbling and boasting is humility and gladness in God. How can you remain humble and make sure Jesus is your source of joy and hope?

What connections have you noticed in Jude? What do these teach you? For instance, where do you see the sin of blasphemy coming up in this letter? What is blasphemy, according to Jude, and why should we be on our guard against it? What else does Jude write that fits this pattern?
