SERMON QUESTIONS

Read Jude 5-7 (Groups: read it twice with different readers)

What lessons do people often need to learn on their own? Think particularly of children. What must they experience for themselves as a way of learning for their future?

Why does Jude pick each of these three instances to help his readers identify false teaching and sinful tendencies? What are the broader warnings they bring?

Read Numbers 14:11. What is the context of this contempt from God? How did the Israelites demonstrate their unbelief?

Read Genesis 6:1-3. Why did God judge these wicked angels? How do we try to usurp God's rightful place as Creator and authority as Lord?

Read Ezekiel 16:49-50. In what ways were Sodom and Gomorrah corrupt? Why does God punish immorality? Do we similarly gratify ungodly desires without regard for his holiness?

Do you feel equipped to hear and read claims about the Bible, godliness, and current culture and respond in a way that takes into account the whole counsel of God and applies the power of the Gospel? If you do not, how are you actively looking to grow in the hopes of doing this?
