SERMON QUESTIONS

Read Isaiah 41:1–10 (Groups: read it twice with different readers)

Read Isaiah 57:15. What is the relationship between God's transcendence and immanence? Why is God perfectly both?

The first thing God says is, "Listen to me..." He's building to a question in verse 4. What is that question? How will the nations respond?

How has Israel behaved similarly to other nations, despite knowing the one true God? What has their idolatry led them to?

What should we do when we feel the pressures of life and are tempted to look for comfort in the world instead of trusting in the sovereignty of God?

Where does our nearness to God come from? Pay special attention to verse 9. Do we first choose God or does he choose us? Why is the difference important and how does it give us a solid assurance of God's loving care?

How is the Lord with us? How does he strengthen his people? When we wonder if he will remain near to us, how does he meet us? Read Romans 5:1-5.
