## **SERMON QUESTIONS**

Read John 5:25–29(Groups read it twice with two different leaders)

What do you think happens to a person after he or she dies? Do you think each person is known and considered by God?

How can Jesus say that the hour for those who are dead to hear him and live is now here (v. 25)? Read John 11:25–26. How can Jesus be the resurrection and the life for us, presently?

Jesus refers to himself as both the Son of God and the Son of Man in these verses? Why are each significant titles? What do they teach us about the nature and mission of Jesus?

Read Daniel 7:13–18. Who is the Son of Man? What is he worthy of and what is he given? What right does Jesus have to claim this title and act as judge?

What is the resurrection of judgment? Why is it important to know that all people will be resurrected, either to eternal life or eternal death?

What does it mean to have "done good" in verse 29? Be careful to note the context. Jesus is speaking about "hearing" his voice? What is the "good" response to hearing the voice of Jesus? What good things will we do after we hear it? Read John 15:5.
