

**SERMON QUESTIONS**

*Read John 12:12-26 (Groups read it twice with two different leaders)*

*What does “Hosanna!” mean and why did the crowd shout this as Jesus came to Jerusalem? What does this say about the expectation of these people? Read Psalm 118:25.*

*Read Zechariah 9:9-11. What kind of king has Jesus come to be? What do these verses say the Messiah will do?*

*What is the significance of “some Greeks” asking to meet Jesus? What does this signal about the nearing conclusion of Jesus’ mission as well as the advance of the Gospel?*

*Why does Jesus compare his impending death to the germination of a seed? How does his death lead to life?*

*How does Jesus receive glory today? What are the characteristics and works of his true followers?*

**QUESTIONS FOR KIDS**

*Read Psalm 118:25. Why are many people waving palm branches and shouting “Hosanna!” as Jesus passes by? Hosanna means “save”. How does God save people?*

*Read John 12:37. People see the work of God, but do not believe in him. Do you believe in Jesus as your Savior? If you do, how can you keep believing in him?*
