SERMON QUESTIONS

Read John 12:12–26 (Groups read it twice with two different leaders)

What does "Hosanna!" mean and why did the crowd shout this as Jesus came to Jerusalem? What does this say about the expectation of these people? Read Psalm 118:25.

Read Zechariah 9:9-11. What kind of king has Jesus come to be? What do these verses say the Messiah will do?

What is the significance of "some Greeks" asking to meet Jesus? What does this signal about the nearing conclusion of Jesus' mission as well as the advance of the Gospel?

Why does Jesus compare his impending death to the germination of a seed? How does his death lead to life?

How does Jesus receive glory today? What are the characteristics and works of his true followers?

QUESTIONS FOR KIDS

Read Psalm 118:25. Why are many people waving palm branches and shouting "Hosanna!" as Jesus passes by? Hosanna means "save". How does God save people?

Read John 12:37. People see the work of God, but do not believe in him. Do you believe in Jesus as your Savior? If you do, how can you keep believing in him?
