What do the first four commandments have in common or what would you say their “theme” is? Do you see any reason for their order?

Read 1 Corinthians 8:4-5. If no other “gods” actually exist why does God forbid their worship? What do people make idols in their lives?

What does it mean that God is “jealous”? What is he jealous for and why is it important to him that his people only worship and serve him?

How do we keep the Sabbath holy as those whose rest is in Christ? See Hebrews 4.

QUESTIONS FOR KIDS

How many of the 10 Commandments do you know? Which one is the hardest for you to obey?

What does it mean to take God's name in vain? Why should we be careful how we talk about God?
