DISCUSSION & APPLICATION QUESTIONS

READ EXODUS 27:20-21, 28:1-5, 29:38-46, 30:1-10

Why is this section bookended by the burning lamps and the burning incense? What do they represent and, more importantly, what do they communicate to us about God's heart toward us?

What picture is the description of the priestly garments supposed to create in the minds of readers? How does a man dressed like this represent something better than this world has to offer?

The priest must be washed, clothed, anointed, and offer a sacrifice in preparation to go before God. How does Jesus do these things once and for all to those who put their faith in him? Read Hebrews 10:22, Galatians 3:26-27, John 17:19, and Hebrews 10:12.

Read Hebrews 10:10-18. Why does the author concentrate on Jesus making a single offering? What assurance does this give us about our position in Christ as believers in Jesus?

What is revealed where the purity of the priest meets the brutality of the sacrifice? How does this help us to understand our holy God, our sinfulness, and God's mercy through Jesus Christ?

QUESTIONS FOR KIDS

Why do we need help coming to God? Why can't we make it to him on our own?

Read 1 Corinthians 6:11. What does it mean to be sanctified and justified? Why do we need to be washed by Jesus?
