DISCUSSION & APPLICATION QUESTIONS

READ EXODUS 32:1-14, 32:30-32, 33:12-23, 34:5-9

Why do the people ask for another god? How does the creation of the calf violate the first four commandments? Where does idolatry lead?

What can we learn from God's response to Moses' first prayer in v. 14? How does God interact with our prayers?

What is important about the confession of sin? What is diminished if we do not understand the magnitude of our betrayal towards God?

How is a heart revived by God? Why is revival the only truly effective path to a full life?

Read John 1:14-18. Given Moses' request to God in Exodus 33:18 and God's answer in v. 20, why is John's introduction of Jesus Christ so revolutionary?
